1. Introduction

To provide the widest dissemination of information about Heart of Tennessee Amateur Radio Emergency Service® (ARES®) and its operational standards, it will maintain a website containing Operation Plans (OP PLAN) and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). Heart of TN. ARES® has obtained domain registration of .com, .net and .org and has established a website under the .com domain name with the other two domains pointing to HOTARES.com.

The Emergency Coordinator (EC) for Heart of TN. ARES® will appoint a Webmaster to maintain the website supporting Heart of TN. ARES®.
